- To respect all other campers, volunteers and instructors
- Listen to all instructions and to do as requested.
- All property brought by campers remain the individual's responsibility whilst at camp. Attendees should not bring any valuables, the FAB Club cannot be held responsible for any losses or damage to these items, this includes money.
- All camps have a NO smoking or vaping policy for ALL campers, without exception.
- All camps have a NO alcohol and NO drugs policy, without exception.
- Campers will only enter other campers' rooms at their invitation, and at no time must there be boys in the girl's rooms, and girls in the boy's rooms.
- Campers must not bring phones, electronic devices or smart devices to camp.
- Bedtimes will be determined at each individual camp and may vary according to the child's age.
- If unacceptable behaviour or situation arises at any camp the FAB Club reserves the right to send the child home. If this situation arises then it is the parent's/ guardian's responsibility to ensure the child is collected from the camp at their own expense.

It is FAB Club's aim for each FAB member to attend camps free of charge. FAB Club is an independent, self-financing charity and must pay for each place booked that is not taken up. We therefore ask to be notified as soon as possible if unable to attend. If FAB incur costs for non-attendance, the charity may review their policy and may need to introduce a deposit system in the future.

FAB Club's insurance policy does not provide personal accident or personal belongings insurance. It is up to the individual to obtain their own if required. If parents / guardians need to contact an adult volunteer whilst at camp, they should use the FAB phone (07821 989845). They may need to leave a message as volunteers do not take the phone out on activities. If their call is urgent, they should contact the activity centre directly. Contact details will be provided prior to the camp.

If unacceptable behaviour or a situation arises at any activity FAB Club reserves the right to send any child or adult home. If this situation occurs, then it is the parent / guardian's responsibility to ensure the child is collected from the activity or camp, at their own expense. If an adult is suspended from an activity or camp, then it will be their responsibility to make their own way home. The disciplinary procedure will then commence
